The protest should be sent to the Office of Legal Services, 200 Mero, Sixth Floor, Transportation Building, Frankfort, KY 40622. THE PROTESTANT SHALL MAIL A COPY OF THE PROTEST TO APPLICANT OR APPLICANT'S ATTORNEY IF ONE IS LISTED, AND STATE IN THE PROTEST THE DATE THE COPY WAS MAILED.

If this Notice of Hearing or any part thereof is incorrect, the applicant must immediately notify the Hearings Clerk at (502) 564-7650 so that a corrected notice can be distributed.

If no protest is filed to an application, the Department may elect to hold a hearing. If a hearing is not required, an order will be sent to the applicant providing the date by which it must file affidavits with the Office of Legal Services in accordance with KRS 281.801 and 601 KAR 1:031.

When a protest is filed, an order will be sent to applicant (or applicant's attorney) directing applicant to contact all protestants (or protestant's attorney) and select an agreeable hearing date, then notify the Hearing Clerk of that date. The Clerk will then issue an order scheduling the date for the hearing. Any party to the hearing may participate in person or be represented by counsel. ANY PARTY WHO IS A CORPORATION MUST BE REPRESENTED BY AN ATTORNEY. Attorney representation shall be at the party's expense. Attorneys shall enter their appearance in the proceeding with the hearing clerk if their representation was not shown on the application or a protest.
